HOW WE IMPLEMENTED YOUR DONATIONS LAST RAMADAN

During the sacred month of Ramadan, Action For Humanity launched a comprehensive aid programme, reaching out to vulnerable families across the world, including Yemen, Syria, Iraq, Turkey, Palestine, Lebanon, Pakistan, Jordan, the UK, Somalia, Afghanistan, and Chad. Our primary objective was to provide essential assistance to communities facing significant challenges during this blessed month.

Throughout Ramadan 2023, we successfully distributed nutritionally balanced **food baskets to 36,387 families**, ensuring sustenance for a family of six for an entire month. Additionally, we extended support to **5,760 families worldwide through cash assistance**, **Zakat**, and **Eid Gifts**, addressing their diverse needs and bringing moments of joy during this special time.

This Ramadan, our commitment remains steadfast. With your generous support, we aim to build upon our previous successes and create an even greater impact on the lives of those in need.

Together, we aspire to continue making a positive difference in the communities we serve during this sacred and compassionate month.

As the situation in Gaza continues to escalate and the need for humanitarian access becomes more crucial, our team is working tirelessly to ensure the safe delivery of aid to Gaza as soon as possible.

TIME TO UNITE AND SUPPORT GAZA

Over 30,000 children, women and men have been killed in Gaza and nearly 70,000 have been severely injured since the start of October 2023.



Over a million people are seeking safety and shelter in the already overcrowded city of Rafah, with hundreds of thousands sleeping in the open with inadequate clothing to stay warm.



Accumulation of solid waste and heightened unsanitary conditions near hospitals, shelters, camps and public areas exacerbates environmental and health risks, with infection and disease outbreak looming.



As each day passes, more people are facing starvation, with limited or no access to food. Children, pregnant women and the elderly are most affected.

TIME TO UNITE AND SUPPORT GAZA

Since the escalation of violence in the region, Action For Humanity has been actively engaged in providing emergency relief, such as food, water, hygiene kits, medical aid and sanitation services, to those affected.

Notably, we stand out as one of the few registered humanitarian organisations operating in the Occupied Palestinian Territories without facing sanctions from any internal entity.

Through your generous donations, Action For Humanity's dedicated team has delivered vital support on the ground:

We assisted with healthcare fees for patients from Gaza in Egypt.



We provided hot meals to over 15,000 people in Gaza since October 2023.



We provided 30 emergency toilets within Rafah including toilets for the disabled.



We transported a mass food shipment of pasta, rice, flour and oil from Egypt to Gaza.



We provided food vouchers, packs, water and hygiene kits to over 40,000 people.



We delivered 54,000 litres of clean water to communities in Gaza.

Our food packs are meticulously curated to contain a variety of high quality, nutritious and culturally appropriate ingredients.

Each country contains different items depending on the location. For example, our food packs in Syria contain rice, sugar, spaghetti, bulgar, sunflower oil, vermicelli, tomato paste, whole lentils, tea, olive oil, thyme and tuna. In Jordan, we distribute cash vouchers that allow people to buy bread, rice, pasta, sugar, oil, meat and canned foods.

Each pack is designed to last at least one month, ensuring there is enough food to sustain a family of six. Often, we distribute these food packs in hard-to-reach areas, ensuring that we are reaching vulnerable families with well balanced, nutritious meals, which can in turn strengthen their resilience and help lead healthier lifestyles.

BREAD DISTRIBUTION

SYRIA AND YEMEN

Bread is a staple food group for millions of people across the Middle East. Our Bread Factory project is a proactive response to deep-rooted challenges in Syria and Yemen, such as the disruption to agricultural production and displacement of whole communities due to the respective crises.

To combat this, our programme focuses on the training and rehabilitation of local bakeries in Syria and Yemen. This initiative not only creates jobs but also generates income for displaced individuals. Remarkably, we have successfully rehabilitated over 50 bakeries in Northwest Syria alone.







This project goes beyond immediate relief. It has also provided Syrian and Yemeni bread makers with the income opportunities they need to remain on their farms and provide for their families.

Your Zakat and Sadaqah will enable us to distribute more bread to more families, offering vital nourishment and relief to families facing intense hardship in these conflictaffected regions.





TIME TO UNITE AND MAKE THE WATER FLOW

Access to water and sanitation is a basic human right – fundamental to everyone's health, dignity and prosperity. However, billions of people are still living without clean water and safely sanitation services.



WATER TRUCKING IN SYRIA

Damaged and disrupted by years of conflict, the lack of safe water, sanitation and hygiene services and facilities have impacted nearly 15 million people in Syria.

Over the years, Action For Humanity has observed the worsening sanitation crisis and its profound impact on the health and wellbeing of affected communities. Our water trucking initiative provides a crucial 35 litres of water per person per day, meeting essential individual daily water needs.





In addition to addressing water scarcity, our dedicated team on the ground is committed to improving and ensuring access to sanitation facilities in camps. Through this initiative, we also facilitate the collection and transfer of waste for 20,000 camp residents. This not only reduces the risk of infection and the spread of diseases within the camp, but also enhances the overall quality of daily living, for those residing in these communities.

Through our efforts and your donations, we can make a tangible and lasting impact on the sanitation and water crisis in northern Syria, fostering healthier and more sustainable living conditions for people living in camps.

WATER WELL REHABILITATION AND RECONSTRUCTION IN YEMEN

In Yemen, a staggering 15.3 million people are deprived of access to safe drinking water and reliable sanitation facilities. This dire situation creates fertile ground for the rapid spread of bacterial diseases, particularly cholera, posing a severe threat to large populations.

In response to these critical conditions, our dedicated team in Yemen is taking action. We are actively involved in the rehabilitation and reconstruction of water wells in Sana'a and Lahij, striving to bring a positive change to more than five war-affected villages.

By ensuring access to safe and clean drinking water, we aim to mitigate the risks associated with water-borne diseases and enhance the wellbeing of the affected communities.







The people of Yemen are in urgent need of support. By uniting together, we can make a meaningful impact on their lives, providing a lifeline of safe water and contributing to the resilience of communities facing the challenges of war and water scarcity.

WATER & SANITATION SERVICES IN PAKISTAN

The water crisis in Pakistan is stark, with over 22 million people lacking access to water in close proximity to their homes. Tragically, this predicament leads to more than 20,000 children under the age of five succumbing to diarrhea annually, a consequence of consuming contaminated water, inadequate sanitation facilities, and poor hygiene conditions.

In response to this pressing issue, **Action For Humanity is actively engaged in constructing solar powered shallow water wells across Pakistan**. This initiative aims to provide communities grappling with water scarcity a clean and easily accessible water source. The focus is on establishing a sustainable and reliable water infrastructure to not only meet the immediate need for clean water but also enhance the overall wellbeing of the local population.







Through the construction of water wells, Action For Humanity is dedicated to making a meaningful and lasting impact on the lives of those affected by the water crisis in Pakistan.

This endeavour represents a critical step toward mitigating the health risks associated with contaminated water and fostering healthier and more sustainable communities.

Last year, Action For Humanity launched the Gift for Life campaign, a compassionate initiative aimed at providing life-changing gifts to individuals facing severe medical limitations. Your support during Ramadan 2023 enabled us to make a meaningful impact:

SUPPORTING NEW MOTHERS IN MATERNITY HOSPITALS

The prolonged conflict in Syria has left many hospitals in the region grappling with severe shortages of basic supplies, fuel, and the capacity to recruit specialized medical professionals. In response to this critical situation, Action For Humanity is actively supporting and sustaining three key hospitals in northeast Syria.

Our efforts encompass covering the salaries of over 350 staff members, providing essential medical and laboratory consumables, stationary, cleaning supplies, and ensuring a continuous supply of fuel for generators, among other vital resources. By addressing these fundamental needs, we aim to fortify the resilience of these hospitals and enhance their capacity to deliver critical healthcare services to those in need.

Through your generous donations, we can provide free consultations for women and children, support infants in incubators and resolve emergency cases every day.

PROSTHETIC LIMBS

FEED THE FASTING IN THE UK

SUHOOR & IFTAR IN THE UK

Our journey began with the establishment of a food bank at the start of the COVID-19 pandemic in March 2020, where we delivered basic food essentials and healthcare packs to hundreds of elderly, isolated and vulnerable individuals in Tameside and Greater Manchester.

Since then, our dedicated team of trained volunteers has provided over 75,000 hot meals to NHS staff, homeless shelters, vulnerable families, and victims of domestic violence. Our hot food provision remains consistent, supplying 150-300 meals per week, and through weekly batch-cooking classes, we have also trained over 200 community cooks to prepare nutritious meals in large quantities, reducing food poverty and further expanding our outreach services to those in need.





This Ramadan, we plan to deliver Suhoor and Iftars through our delivery partners, Aid Infinity, who are working with refugees and asylum seekers in Loughborough.

These families and individuals have fled from countries like Afghanistan, Iran, Iraq,
Pakistan, Sudan, Syria and Yemen, with many lacking access and means to culturally appropriate food.

Action For Humanity will provide essential food items to each family, such as meat, bread, olives, honey and dates. In addition to this, nutritionally balanced hot meal iftars will be delivered each week throughout Ramadan for the families to enjoy.

All meals will be freshly prepared with items sourced ethically, cooked and delivered by our trusted volunteers.

Providing iftar for a struggling refugee this Ramadan will be more than just food assistance - it shows the solid support of a community behind them and gives hope for the future.





REBUILDING SYRIA

ONE VILLAGE AT A TIME - HOUSING PROJECT (PHASE 3)

Action For Humanity has now successfully completed three phases of our Rebuilding Syria programme. The initial phase saw the provision of new homes for 250 families (Village Ataa), followed by the second phase benefiting 500 families (Village Massa). The upcoming third phase is set to bring an additional 750 families with new homes. Going beyond housing, our commitment extends to constructing essential community facilities such as a school, health centre, and mosque, designed to meet the specific needs of the community.

Going beyond housing, our commitment extends to constructing essential community facilities. This includes a school, a health centre, and a mosque, designed to meet the specific needs of the community.






These facilities will play a crucial role in addressing various aspects of community wellbeing. The school will offer educational opportunities, the health centre will provide essential healthcare services, and the mosque will serve as a place of worship and community gathering. Each facility will be staffed with trained professionals, ensuring that the community receives comprehensive support.

Through this holistic approach, our aim is not only to provide shelter but also to create a sustainable and supportive environment for families in Northen Syria. By addressing the broader needs of the community, we strive to contribute to improving the living conditions and futures of those affected by displacement and conflict in Syria.



Each home unit will be 30m² in size. These units will serve as temporary homes for internally displaced people currently living in camps and informal settlements.



Building resilient communities through livelihood support means that when catastrophe inevitably strikes, the families we support are better prepared to weather the storm and come out of the other side stronger.

LIVELIHOOD SUPPORT

YEMEN

Yemen continues to grapple with one of the world's most severe humanitarian crises, impacting approximately 23.4 million people, including nearly 13 million children. A staggering 80% of the country's population faces the harsh reality of struggling to secure basic sustenance.

In response to this dire situation, Action For Humanity is actively collaborating with local families in Yemen to restore their means of livelihood, addressing the lack of basic necessities and critical need for life-saving income opportunities. By working closely with these communities, we strive to bring about positive change, enhance food security, and create sustainable avenues for income generation. Through these efforts, we aim to contribute to the wellbeing and resilience of the affected population in Yemen during these challenging times.
