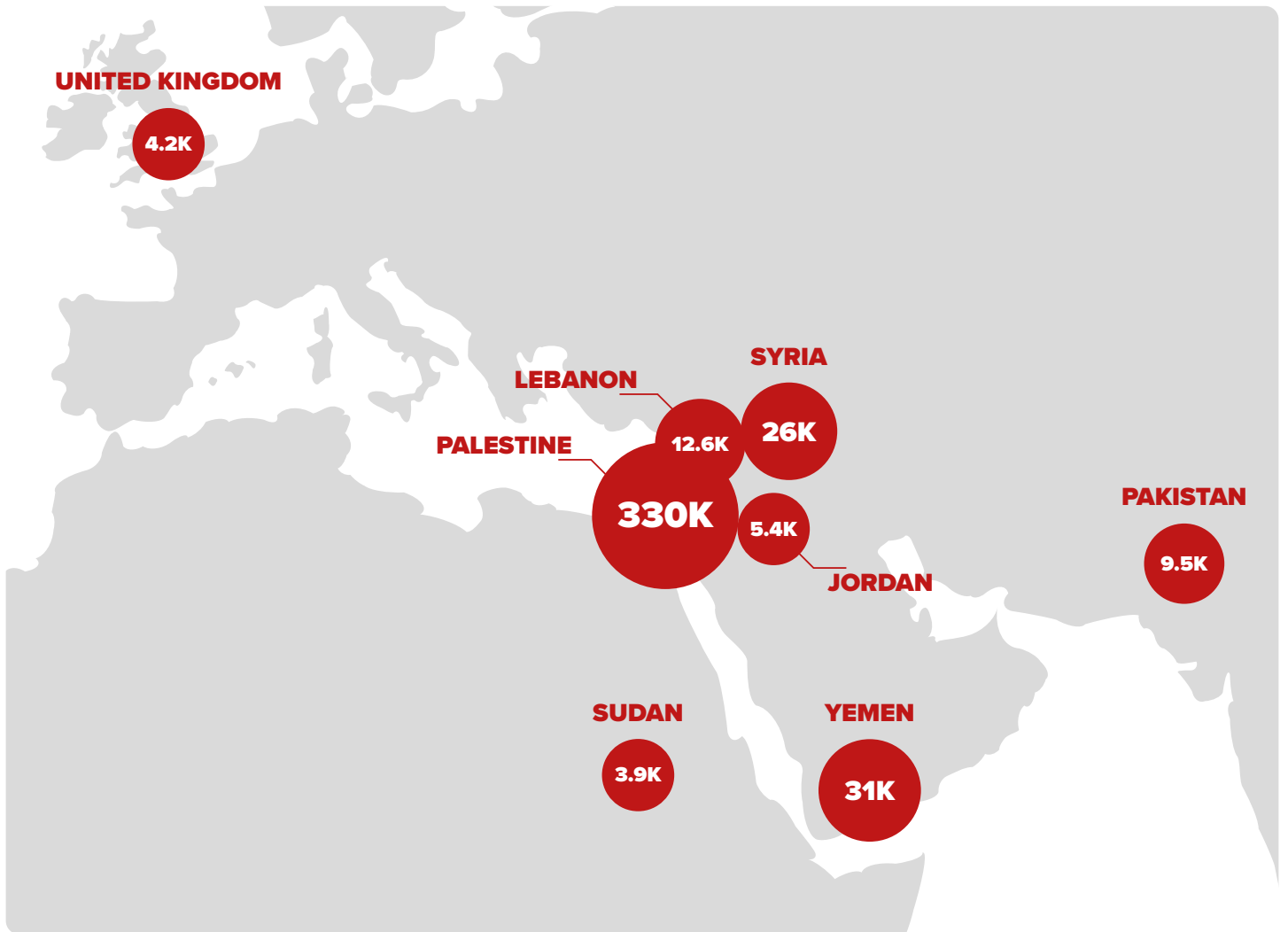


GLOBAL IMPACT OVERVIEW

FAITH IN ACTION, WORLDWIDE

This Ramadan, your generosity reached over 423,000 people across eight countries.

Across the world, families were able to access food, clean water, and essential humanitarian support when they needed it most. And beyond immediate relief, your support helped strengthen the foundations communities rely on to endure and recover from crisis.

We reached 423,727 people in eight countries this Ramadan — a huge increase from last year.

HOT MEALS

We delivered 106,491 hot meals to displaced families, refugees, and vulnerable people across the world.



1.9M+
LITRES OF CLEAN WATER

Hundreds of water trucks delivered 1.9 million litres of clean water to 261,500 people in Palestine.



39K+
FOOD PARCELS

We distributed 39,614 food parcels, supporting families with staple ingredients they could rely on throughout Ramadan.

FOOD SECURITY

In Gaza, hunger has reached catastrophic levels. Families are going days without food. Children are going to bed hungry, and in some cases, dying from malnutrition and lack of access to basic nutrition. Across Yemen and Syria, millions of people continue to face severe food insecurity, with families relying on humanitarian support to meet even their most basic needs.

This Ramadan, your support helped families access food during one of the most difficult times. In Gaza, where access to food is severely restricted, your support helped families break their fast with warm meals and receive food to last beyond a single day. In Yemen, families received consistent support throughout the month, while in Syria, food assistance helped displaced households manage daily life with greater stability.

WATER, SANITATION, AND HYGIENE

Access to clean water remains critically limited across Palestine. Damage to infrastructure and ongoing restrictions mean many families are forced to rely on unsafe or insufficient water sources. This increases the risk of illness, particularly for children.

This Ramadan, your support helped deliver safe, clean water to communities facing severe shortages.

HEALTH AND MEDICAL SUPPORT

In many conflict-affected areas, healthcare systems are under extreme strain or no longer fully functioning. Across the Middle East, access to medical care remains limited, particularly for those with serious or life-changing injuries.

Malak, Gaza

In Gaza, Malak’s life was changed forever when an airstrike struck the building where her family had taken shelter. She lost both of her parents and three of her siblings, and was pulled from the rubble with severe injuries.

To save her life, doctors were forced to amputate her leg. In the weeks that followed, Malak received ongoing medical care and support from Action For Humanity medical teams. Despite everything she had endured, her recovery began.

Today, with continued treatment and rehabilitation, Malak has received a prosthetic leg, giving her the chance to walk again and begin rebuilding her life.

ZAKAT SUPPORT

For many families, the challenge is not only rising costs and inflation, but the complete loss of income and the lack of stable work. Across countries like Yemen, Syria, and Jordan, households are struggling to meet even their most basic needs. For some, there is no reliable source of income at all.

Through Zakat, your support provided direct financial assistance, giving families the flexibility to prioritise what they needed most, whether that was

food, medicine, rent, or other essential costs. This type of support is vital in situations where needs are complex and constantly changing. It allows families to make decisions based on their own circumstances, helping them manage daily life with greater stability.

This Ramadan, your Zakat supported over 11,800 people, providing practical relief at a time when it was needed most.

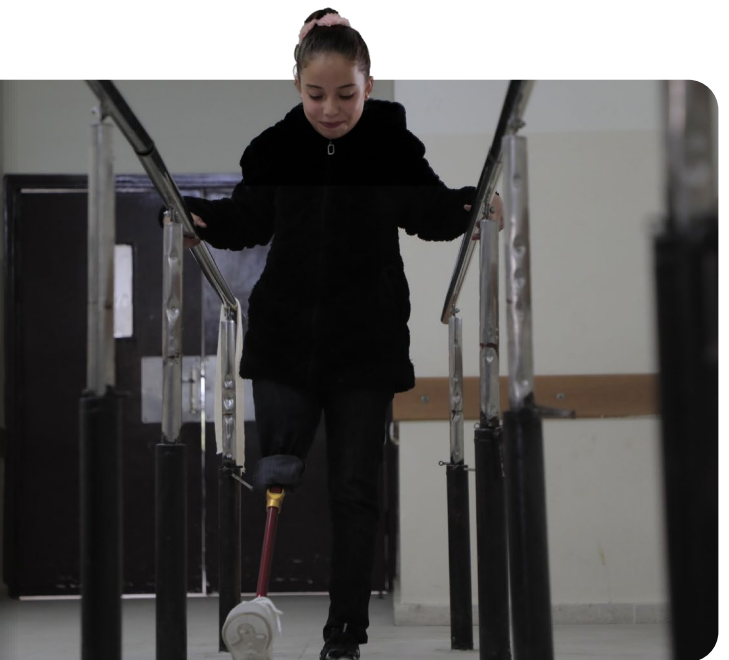

At a time when families are facing extreme hunger, limited access to clean water, and ongoing displacement, your support provided essential relief. Families were able to break their fast with warm meals, access clean water for daily use, and receive medical care where services remain limited. In the face of immense hardship, your support helped families get through each day with greater dignity.

ACTION IN THE COMMUNITY

Alongside our humanitarian response, Ramadan was a time to bring people together to raise awareness, strengthen partnerships, and keep the focus on communities facing crisis.

MANCHESTER RAMADAN RECEPTION

In Manchester, our annual Ramadan reception was hosted at Hotel Football alongside Mayor Andy Burnham, bringing together business leaders, activists, MPs, Consulates General, and humanitarian partners.

The evening reflected our strong connection to the city and marked the success of our collaboration with the Manchester United Muslim Supporters Club, whose visit to Jordan raised over **£300,000** in support of Palestinian refugees.



EID RECEPTION IN WESTMINSTER

In Westminster, our Eid reception brought together MPs, members of the House of Lords, and campaigners. The evening was keynote-led by Palestinian Ambassador to the UK Husam Zomlot, with contributions from Baroness Julie Elliott, MP Alistair Carmichael, AFH CEO Othman Moqbel, and Chris Doyle, Director of Caabu.

While guests gathered to mark Eid, the focus remained on the realities facing communities in Palestine, Syria, Yemen, and Sudan, and the importance of continued awareness and advocacy.

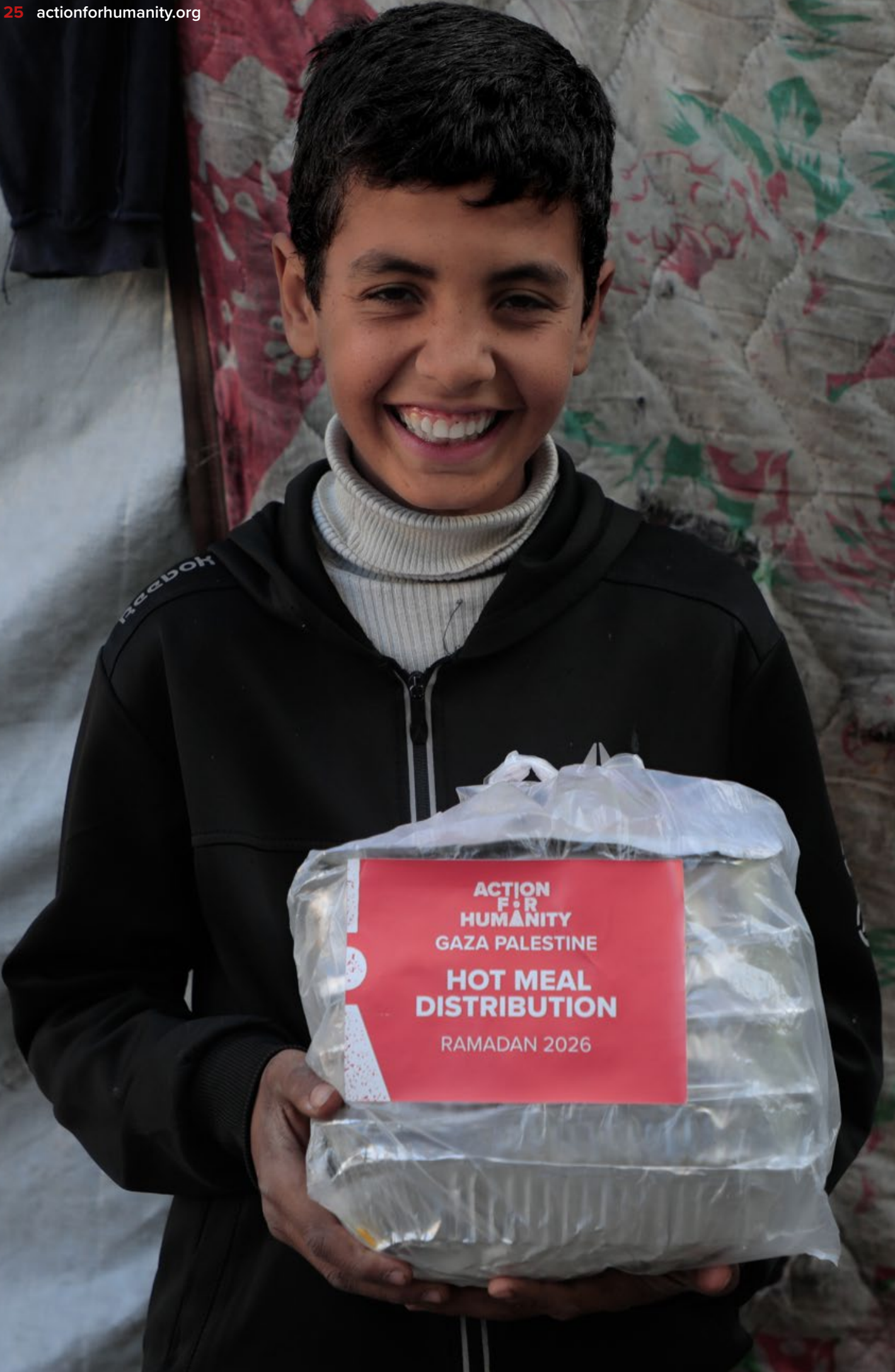
